SPECIES AVAILABLE

Large Shade Trees

Planetree 'Exclamation' – 55-65' tall x 40-50' wide; pyramidal form; best in full sun; maple-shaped leaves; unusual attractive bark; yellow-tan-brown fall color



Maple 'Sienna Glen' – 40-50' tall x 35-40' wide; hybrid of two native species; pyramidal with strong leader; full sun for best color; orange-red fall color; mostly seedless



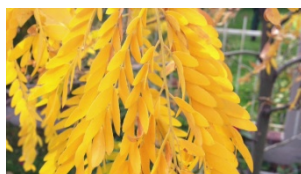
Sugar Maple 'Green Mountain' – 40-50' tall x 30-40' wide; native; straight central trunk; oval crown; full sun to part shade; orange-red fall color



Ginkgo 'Magyar' – 40-60' tall x 20-30' wide; narrow, upright habit with somewhat open crown; best in full sun; fan-shaped leaves; yellow fall color



Honeylocust 'Shademaster' – 35-45' tall x 30' wide; native; crown less dense--provides filtered shade; full sun to part shade; small leaflets; gold fall color



Littleleaf Linden 'Greenspire' – 40-50' tall x 30' wide; pyramidal form; best in full sun; small yellow flowers in spring; heart shaped leaves; gold fall color



Smaller Ornamental Trees

Elm 'Patriot' – 40'-50' tall x 40' wide; native; full sun to part shade; excellent resistance to Dutch elm disease; glossy green leaves; gold fall color



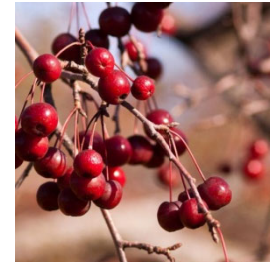
Ohio Buckeye 'Early Glow' – 30' tall and wide; native; full sun to part shade; interesting flowers and leaves; large seeds loved by squirrels; red-orange fall color



Serviceberry 'Autumn Brilliance' – 15'-20' tall and wide; hybrid of two native species; full sun to part shade; small white flowers in spring are followed by sweet red berries taken by birds; orange fall color



Crabapple 'Pink Spires' – 15' tall x 12' wide; upright form; full sun; leaves reddish in spring; pink flowers; yellow fall color; small, purple-red fruits persist into winter and provide late food for birds



Crabapple 'Sugar Tyme' – 12' tall and wide; upright habit; full sun; white flowers; gold fall color; small, red fruits persist into winter and feed birds



Crabapple 'Purple Prince' – 18' tall and wide; rounded form; full sun; leaves are purplish in spring, green in summer, & yellow in fall; rose red flowers; small, purple fruits persist into winter--late food for birds
